


ABOUT THE PAGE EDUCATION FOUNDATION

In 1988, to mark his induction into the National Football League Hall of Fame, Diane and Alan Page founded the Page Education Foundation. For more than 30 years, the Foundation has awarded scholarships to more than 7,500 Minnesota students of color pursuing their post-secondary education. In exchange for financial support, recipients, known as Page Scholars, contribute to our community by mentoring children in kindergarten through eighth grade. Through their service, Page Scholars develop leadership skills while inspiring and giving hope to the children they serve. To date, Page Scholars have volunteered nearly 500,000 hours inspiring 50,000 children. For the 2019-2020 academic year, 567 Page Scholars will be awarded \$945,250 in Page Grants and will work with as many as 7,500 children.

BECOME A SUSTAINING PARTNER

The Page Education Foundation's goal is to increase the number of scholarships without increasing its annual fixed costs. To achieve this goal, the Foundation is rolling out a Sustaining Partnership Program in 2020.
