ABOUT THE PAGE EDUCATION FOUNDATION

Education gives people the power of choice. The power of choice is the power of liberty. Recognizing that disparities in academic opportunity deny children of color both choice and liberty, Diane and Alan Page started the Page Education Foundation in 1988. The Foundation's goal is to encourage, motivate, and assist Minnesota's students of color in the pursuit of post-secondary education, and, in the process, change the future. The Foundation achieves that goal by providing financial assistance to students pursuing post-secondary education, and most important, by requiring its Page Scholars to work with young children, kindergarten through eighth grade, specifically in the area of education. The first year the Foundation had 10 Page Scholars; now we have more than 500 annually. Since then, the Foundation has awarded over \$16 million in grants to more than 8,000 Page Scholars. Those Page Scholars have volunteered nearly 500,000 hours, working with 50,000 children across Minnesota. In the end, our Scholars are bending the moral arc of the universe towards justice.

The Page Education Foundation's goal is to increase the number of scholarships without increasing its annual fixed costs. To achieve this goal, the Foundation is rolled out a Sustaining Partnership Program.
